

Archie Miller Basketball Day Camp

Frequently Asked Questions

Where will the camp take place?

- The camp will take place on the Indiana University Athletic Campus. We will primarily use two facilities that are next door to each other: Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall (SSAH) and Cook Hall.

What time does camp start?

- Camp will begin in the Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall Court Area at 9:00 a.m. each day. On the first day of camp, please check-in at the registration area in the South Lobby of SSAH prior to entering the court area. Campers should report directly to the SSAH court area on Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday upon arrival.

What time does camp end?

- The camp will end at 4:00 p.m. each day in Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. Please make sure that you have a ride arranged for your child at 4:00 p.m. each day.

Where do I go the first day of camp to register/check-in?

- Registration will take place in the front entrance (south) lobby area of Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall on Monday, June 22nd between 8:00-8:50 a.m.

I submitted a waiver when I registered online, do I need to bring anything else to registration?

- Yes! We need to collect a hard copy of the signed waiver and release form from every participant. The waiver form will be emailed out closer to camp.

What is the rough schedule for each day?

- Daily schedule is subject to change. Thursday's schedule will be different and will be emailed out during camp week.

What happens the final day of camp (Thursday)? What is “Championship Day”?

- Thursday is “Championship Day” in Camp. All campers will play their final two tournament games in the afternoon that day (between approximately 1:20 p.m. and 3:30 p.m.). We will then have a brief Awards Ceremony at approximately 3:30 p.m., and campers will have an opportunity to get autographs from Indiana players and staff at the conclusion of camp. T-shirts will be distributed at the Awards Ceremony.

Can I watch the camp?

- Yes, you are more than welcome to sit in the stands and watch camp.

Is lunch provided?

- No. Campers may bring their own lunch or purchase pizza in the morning before each camp day begins. We will take pizza orders at registration / check-in either for the week or on a daily basis. Pizza will be sold for \$2 per slice. You will indicate type of pizza, number of slices, and the specific days that you wish to purchase when ordering at check-in.

Will there be drinks and snacks for the campers to buy?

- Yes. Campers will be able to purchase drinks and snacks. \$10 Punch Cards will be available for sale on the first day of camp so that campers will not need to hold onto cash during the day. Additional cards can be purchased throughout the week at the beginning of each camp day. Please plan to pay cash for pizza and punch cards, but checks will be accepted written to “Archie Miller Basketball Camp”.

Will there be anyone to take care of my camper if they get hurt or don’t feel well during camp?

- Yes, a certified health care supervisor will be available at every session to provide medical assistance if needed. Please let us know if you have any special concerns at registration.

Where do the campers put their belongings?

- If your child brings a bag/ lunch/ water bottle to camp, please have him place the bag/ lunch/ water bottle in the stands in SSAH when he arrives each day. We do not want any bags on the court level where camp is taking place. Please do not have your child bring anything of significant value to camp as we cannot be responsible for items that are lost or stolen.

Will there be a time for autographs from Coach Miller and the players?

- Yes. Autographs will be available the last day of camp. We will also have a limited supply of autograph panel basketballs available for purchase. If you would like to purchase a ball, we strongly recommend that you do it at this time, and then you can have the ball available for your child on the last day of camp for autographs after the conclusion of the Awards Ceremony. Each ball costs \$30, and they will be sold on a first-come, first-served basis throughout the week.
